This month's selection is extra special for us. To start, this wine and producer has been on our shelves off and on whenever it's available for the last few years. This beautiful orange wine is a go-to for staff and always sells out quickly. All of that is reason enough to feature it for your benefit, but to make this selection even more meaningful it's our chance to support this amazing winery in a serious time of need. In late August the winery's region experienced the heaviest rainfall it has seen in over 50 years. This caused the Maule River to rise to its highest ever recorded level, which led to devastating flooding throughout the region. The winemakers and owners at Viña González Bastías, Daniela and José Luis, experienced major damage to both their winery and home. They're in the process of figuring out what rebuilding looks like, but in the meantime supporting producers like them and others in the Maule Valley is one of the best things we can do.

This stellar orange wine never fails to impress when opened. It announces itself in any setting with a gorgeous bouquet of floral and fruity notes, with a bone dry and slightly textured finish. Plus, it's gorgeous to drink at sunset since it matches perfectly!
