"La Frontière" means the border, limit, or boundary, and this wine smashes that concept just as well as Queen Bey herself with her new album Cowboy Carter. It's got R&B, soul, pop, hip-hop, rock and country, and they're fused in a way that can only be described as Bey's take on a truly Americana project. Similarly, Division's Wine Co set out to create a wine beyond borders or geographic boundaries like wine is usually crafted, by picking grapes from sites that span from Oregon wine country through Washington's, and while the wine is truly unique in its flavor profile; it is decidedly American(a). "This pretty little thing" has fruit that is ripe and lush; yet not overwhelming, and is anchored by a minerally and zestiness, it's truly sublime and unlike any Savvy B we've ever tried. We are as obsessed with it as we are the new Beyoncé album. We were only able to get a case, so we knew it had to go in wine club. We could, "ramble on, could go on, but we're going silent" to let the wine do the talking!

One of the most interesting Savvy B's we've tried in a long time! Tropical, citrus zest, minerally with a slight "I can't believe it's not butter" creamy finish that works mind blowingly well!
